

LETTER OF JOHN PAUL II ON THE OCCASION OF THE 75th BIRTHDAY OF CARDINAL ANGELO SODANO

To my Venerable Brother Cardinal Angelo Sodano Secretary of State

The observance of your impending birthday, Your Eminence, gives me the welcome opportunity of expressing my congratulations and my cordial best wishes to you. I gladly join you in your gratitude to the Lord for the many gifts he has given you, enabling you, in a variety of responsibilities, to perform valuable service to the Church and, in a special way, to this Apostolic See. I am also happy to express my personal gratitude to you as my closest collaborator for the great help that for years you have given me daily in the exacting mission of Secretary of State.
