TO THE OFFICERS AND BUREAU CHIEFS OF NBC NEWS *Saturday, 27 September 1986* Dear

Friends, It is a pleasure for me to greet you on the occasion of your coming to Rome for the annual meeting of the officers and bureau chiefs of NBC News from throughout the world.
