The scientific, philosophical and theological hermeneutics of the 'Book of Nature' as a path of hope, will take place in Rome on the days 10, 11 and 12 September, and invites all the participants to seek ways that allow man to "rise above all things that can be measured to see the measure without measure; to surpass all beings that can be counted to contemplate the number that has no number; to exalt himself above all things that can be weighed in order to observe the weight that has no weight" (Saint Augustine, *De Genesi ad litteram*, IV, 3, 8).
