Press communiqué of the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue on the meeting with the Office of Interreligious Dialogue and Cooperation of the World Council of Churches

The staff members of the Office of Interreligious Dialogue and Cooperation (IRDC) of the World Council of Churches (WCC) as well as their colleagues from the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue (PCID), held their annual meeting at the PCID Offices on 30-31 January 2017.

Both the delegations expressed their appreciation for the opportunity to meet a few days after the conclusion of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.
