H.E. Mr. Julio Aníbal Riaño Velandia was born on 3 March 1949 and is married with two children.

He graduated in international law and diplomacy from the *Jorge Tadeo Lozano Universidad de Bogotà*, then he received a master's degree in regional economics from the Federal University of Brazil)

He has held, among others, the following offices: editorialist for issues concerning Amazonia; professor at the Javeriana University, Colombian Academy of History; director of theses of the *Jorge Tadeo Lozano Universidad de Bogotà*; university professor of diplomatic law, international protocol and politics, *Jorge Tadeo Lozano Universidad de Bogotà*; official at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1974); deputy director of protocol at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; minister-embassy counsellor in Argentina; director general for Asia, Africa and Oceania at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; director general of protocol at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1994-1999); ambassador to Costa Rica (1999-2006); director general of protocol at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2006-2011); minister of the embassy in Mexico (2011-2013); and ambassador to Salvador (since 2013).
